

Premium Data Package adds Nikkei High Dividend Yield 50 and launches JPX-Nikkei Mid Small Version

Nikkei Inc. will expand “Premium Data Package” (PDP), a subscription-based web data service as of May 17, 2017. From the day, the data files of the Nikkei 225 High Dividend Yield Stock 50 Index will be available on its “Nikkei 225 Version”. Nikkei also starts the “JPX-Nikkei Mid Small Version” of the PDP, which provides the detailed data of the JPX-Nikkei Mid and Small Index.

1: Add Nikkei High Dividend Yield 50 data files

The Nikkei High Dividend Yield 50 data files such as Component Data and Advance Notice etc. will be added on the “Nikkei 225 Version”. The subscribers of the PDP (Nikkei 225 Version) are able to download the various Nikkei index related data including Nikkei 225 as well as the other Nikkei indexes from the registered website and receive emails on the index related news such as changes in the constituents just after Nikkei’s announcements. The current subscribers can use the Nikkei High Dividend Yield 50 data files without the additional fee. The following table overviews the data file names and the content.

2: JPX-Nikkei Mid Small Version launches

The JPX-Nikkei Mid Small Version provides the data related to JPX-Nikkei Mid and Small Index, jointly developed by Nikkei Inc. and Tokyo Stock Exchange, Inc. which has been calculated and published since March 2017. The subscribers are able to download the JPX-Nikkei Mid Small related data including the index level, and constituent (stock, shares, Free-Float Weight and divided) from the registered website and receive emails on the index related news such as changes in the JPX-Nikkei Mid Small constituents, as the subscribers of the JPX-Nikkei 400 Version (launched in April 2014) can obtain the data for the index. To start using the JPX-Nikkei Mid Small Version, it is necessary to conclude a separate license agreement. The following table overviews the data file names and the content.
