

## Deletion from Nikkei Climate PAB Index

March 5, 2026 – On April 1, Nikkei Inc. will delete GS Yuasa Corporation (6674) and CASIO COMPUTER CO., LTD. (6952) from the constituents of the Nikkei 225 Climate Change 1.5°C Target Index (EU PAB) (Nikkei Climate PAB Index) due to the deletion from the Nikkei Stock Average (Nikkei 225) as a result of the periodic review. When a constituent is removed from the Nikkei 225, the same constituent stock will also be deleted from the Nikkei Climate PAB Index on the same date.

Note that no stock will be added to the Nikkei Climate PAB Index when a constituent is removed not by periodic reviews. The next periodic review is planned at the end of this April.

Additionally, due to the establishment of a holding company with Mitsubishi Fuso Truck and Bus Corporation, HINO MOTORS, LTD. (7205) will be removed from the index on April 1 and the new holding company, ARCHION Corporation (543A) will be added to the index on the same day, its listing date.

Please note that the market capitalization of HINO MOTORS used in the calculation of the closing value of the index on March 27, the final trading day, will be used in the index calculation on March 30, the delisting day, and on March 31, the previous day of its exclusion.
