

Changes in the Nikkei Progressive and High Dividend Stock Index constituents

June 12, 2026 – Nikkei Inc. will change the Nikkei Progressive and High Dividend Stock Index constituents as a result of the Periodic Review of 2026. The changes shown below will become effective from June 30.

The base date for the Periodic Review was May 29. Among stocks listed in Japan (excluding TOKYO PRO Market), the top 30 stocks with the highest dividend yields (dividends are Nikkei forecasts) were selected from “progressive dividend” stocks that have either increased or maintained dividends without reducing them for at least 10 years on an actual basis. Higher yield non-constituents are added while lower yield current constituents are removed. The weighted average dividend yield of the index as of May 29 based on the new 30 constituents was 4.33%.
