### Monthly Summary of the Tokyo Market

- The Nikkei Stock Average (Nikkei 225) closed October at <u>22,977.13</u>, declined 207.99 points (0.89%) from the end of September. The infection cases of the COVID-19 has spread again especially in the European countries and the United States. The concerns for world economic stagnation has been recognized again in the Japanese equity market. As a result, the index fell under 23,000-mark first time since July as the end of the month value.
- The sentiment of "wait and see" the results of the US Presidential election has grown in the market. The market was slow and the trading value per day was below 2 trillion yen (approximately 19 billion dollars) for 12 consecutive days in the middle of the month. Investors were waiting for the major Japanese companies to announce their latest financial results toward the end of the month, which contributed to low trading activities during the month.
- Due to a system failure of the Tokyo Stock Exchange, trading of all the listed stocks were halted all day on October 1st. Under such a circumstance, Nikkei Inc. decided open, high, low, and closing values of the Nikkei Stock Average as 23,185.12, the same value as the previous day. On October 2nd, the trading came back to normal.




