Monthly Summary of the Tokyo Market

- The Nikkei Stock Average (Nikkei 225) closed September at <u>29452.66</u>, gained 1363.12 points (4.85%) from the end of August. In the middle of the month, it hit 30670.10, over 31-year high since August 1st, 1990.
- On September 3, Japan's Prime Minister, Yoshihide Suga announced he would not run for the Presidential Election of the Liberal Democratic Party (LDP). With expectation of the new administration's economic policy, the index rally continued, and the index bounced up 4-5% in the first and second week. Progress of the Covid-19 vaccination and rapid reduction of the new infection cases accelerated expectations on the recovery of the economic activities.
- However, toward the end of the month, concerns over financing of the Evergrande, a major Chinese real-estate developer, emerged and the index dropped below 30,000 mark.




