## Monthly & Annual Summary of the Tokyo Market

#### > Summary of the month

- The Nikkei Stock Average (Nikkei 225) closed December 2022 at <u>26094.50</u>, dropped 1874.49 points (6.70%) from the end of November. With the U.S. Federal Reserve's decision to keep tightening its monetary policy, the index was in downtrend as worries over global economy rose.
- Bank of Japan shocked the market by sudden announcement to review its ultra-easy rate policy where the benchmark interest rate cap was raised to 0.5% from 0.25%. It was interpreted as an initial step to tighten its monetary policy, and the Nikkei 225 fell sharply toward the end of the month. Also, investors were worried about the effect of China's surge of infection cases of the Covid-19 over the outlook of the global economy.
- The <u>Nikkei 225 Climate Change 1.5°C Target Index</u>, a new member of the Nikkei indices which was jointly developed with the U.S. Wilshire fell to 25951.72, lost 1909.29 (6.85%) since the end of November.

### > Summary of the year

- On the annual basis, the Nikkei 225 closed the year down 2697.21 points (9.36%) from 2021. It posted first annual loss since 2018 when the trade friction between U.S. and China became heated. The market was sensitive to the U.S. interest rate policy and worried about the global economic situation influenced by tightening monetary policies among major central banks, as well. Although historically weak Japanese Yen against U.S. Dollar was expected to help Japanese exporting firms raise their profitability, policy surprise by the Bank of Japan to review its yield curve control cast a shadow over the Japanese equity market sentiment at the end of the year.
- The <u>Nikkei 225 Climate Change 1.5°C Target Index</u> lost 2939.34 points (10.17%) annually.


